A formal Bid Proposal Package must be requested from A.Gail.Dungan@humboldt.edu in order to bid, which is only obtainable by prequalified contractors, "B" licensed in the State of California, and registered with the DIR. This package will contain the only valid Bid Proposal Form. Once all three (3) conditions are confirmed fulfilled, the Bid Proposal Package will emailed to the contractor no earlier than five (5) days prior to the date set for opening bids (Wednesday, November 18, 2020).

Bids must be delivered by email to both A.Gail.Dungan@humboldt.edu and procure@humboldt.edu no later than 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 18, 2020.

Bidder must include a Bidders Bond in the amount of \$25,000 with their bid. The form to be used is included in the IFB documents.

Prevailing Wages

The contract resulting from this IFB is for public works projects and is subject to prevailing wage rate laws. The applicable prevailing wage rates are included in the IFB documents. Bidders shall register with the Department of Industrial Relations at http://www.dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/PublicWorks.html in order to bid and to provide certified payroll to DIR after award.

Small Business Preference

(See Section 2.10 Small Business Five Percent Bid Advantage, Contract General Conditions for Job Order Contracts)

Bidder requesting 5% Small Business Preference must submit with their bid proposal a completed "Request for Small Business Five Percent Preference Certification" form.

DVBE Incentive

(See Section 2.12 Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Participation Requirement, Contract General Conditions for Job Order Contracts)

The Awarded Contractor will be required to meet or exceed the 3% DVBE participation requirement on each Job Order. For bidding, a DVBE incentive is offered from None to 3%, to correlate to the level of participation proposed.

If the lowest responsive, responsible bidder is a California small business, the only bidders eligible for the DVBE incentive will be California certified small businesses.
