### **1. RFQ Submittal Due Date.**

RFQ Statement of Qualifications Submittal due date has not been changed and remains Wednesday, November 9, 2022, by 3:00 p.m.

### **2. Questions and Answers**

**Question 1:** Please confirm if the pre-proposal meetings scheduled for November 29th are virtual or in-person?

**Answer:** Meetings will be held via Zoom

**Question 2:** Will the pre-proposal meetings on 11/29/22 be held with all shortlisted teams collectively, or will individual confidential meetings be held?

**Answer:** Meeting will be held with each of the firms separately.

**Question 3:** Are the Feasibility Study and Programming Architects/Consultants eligible to pursue the DB project?

**Answer:** The prime consultant, Suarez-Kuehne Architecture, is excluded from participating in the CDB process. Sub-consultants are not excluded.

**Question 4:** Will the points from the RFQ phase carry into the RFP phase?

**Answer:** No.

**Question 5:** In one document, you specify no more than 5 firms will be shortlisted; in another, it says 4. Curious which is correct

**Answer:** Four firms will be shortlisted

**Question 6:** Do you have a DVBE utilization goal for this project?

**Answer:** Yes, three percent (3%) minimum.

**Question 7:** Under the experience section relevant to this project, are all projects included required to be completed or can they be in design or construction?

**Answer:** No, projects do not need to be complete, but indicate the current status of in-progress experience. As stated in RFP Section 8, each criteria will be judged “against an ideal response” which may favor completed projects.
